Dear Vendors,

It is hard to believe that this year will be the eighth year of “Arts on the Perquimans”... sponsored by the Perquimans Arts League! It will also be my first year as Committee Chair for this event and I am thrilled to be a part of this well-known and respected art & crafts show. I look forward to meeting all of you! Remember, we will be located at 310 Granby Street in Hertford. We are excited as we begin our planning and we hope you will be able to join us whether it’s your first time or as a returning vendor.

This year we will be adding some new and exciting things! First, we are offering spaces OUTSIDE. They will be 10 x 10 spaces to the left of the rec center, in the grassy area. Vendors will need to be responsible for their own canopy or tent (for rain/sun purposes). Outside vendors will be charged \$30 per space...payment after June 1st will be \$40. This year, inside spaces will be \$40 for the regular 8 x 9 space...payment after June 1st will be \$50. We are also working on a new food vendor, some music and much more!

I will be emailing you later as we solidify our plans!

As always, you will still need to bring your own 6ft table(s) and display pieces. Please, no tall walls or corrals without permission and don’t forget to indicate on your application if you require a folding chair. If you have any questions regarding this, please call me.

Just a reminder that spaces have sold out very quickly in the past, so please submit your forms as soon as possible to insure your spot. Spaces with electricity are very limited so please keep that in mind. They will be given on a first come, first served basis.
